PLFN EMO COVID Update:

We know that the holidays are a time for family to be together but we know this holiday season will look different.

In order to protect our community and especially our Elders we are asking those students and other family members coming to Pictou Landing First Nations for the holiday to arrange for an Asymptomatic COVID-test prior to traveling home.

This test will not be a guarantee you are COVID free when you are home because you may come into it after you are tested but it is a good step in preventing the spread of COVID to our community.

Asymptomatic testing is available until December 18th but may extend depending on need. To get a asymptomatic test you can visit the Covid-self assessment at <https://covid-self-assessment.novascotia.ca/en>. Once there select asymptomatic test. Then select the "I want a test" option. It will then give you options to have tests done at various sites across the province.

We want to make sure community members are also taking precautions by keeping gatherings small and under 10 people, limiting the number of people you are spending time with, wearing masks, and washing your hands.
