With this document we certify that **Danny Konijn** took part in a project called **STAR - Stand Together Against Racism**. It was a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC). The project was organised by **Cazalla Intercultural**, in cooperation with **Pro European Network (Bulgaria)**, **Association for Children and Young People CHANCE (Poland)**, **Rete educare ai diritti umani (Italy)**.

A MOOC is an online course aimed at wide participation and open access via the Internet. It provides materials for studying from distance, presented through videos, readings, and other media, and engages learners through forums to encourage interaction and feedback. Carried out in the context of Erasmus+ Programme, the MOOCs focus on the priority areas of the programme.

Altogether, **859** people took part in the project.

### The overall aim and specific objectives of the project:

The aim is to share practices and tools Stand Together Against (invisible) Racism.

Objectives:

- a) to explore the frequent root causes of racism, understand what invisible racism is and its relation to power
- b) to explore the racist hate speech
- c) to discover the aims, methods and practice of anti-racism education, anti-racist actions and understand the importance of reacting
- d) to everyday racism to share practices and experiences in tackling visible and invisible racism with young people
